

## CALL FOR PROPOSALS

### ENHANCING COMMUNITY BASED REHABILITATION IN AMMAN

**DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS: 28 FEBRUARY**

You Able Onlus is pleased to announce a call for proposals to support the development of **2 CBID program (ex RBC - Community Based Rehabilitation, actually named CBID Community Based Inclusive Development)** in line with the Guidelines on **CBID** and the Convention on the rights of persons with disabilities (CRPD) **to be realized by a maximum of 4 people in Jordan.**

Community Based Rehabilitation, initiated by the World Health Organization (WHO) in 1978, was promoted as a strategy to improve access to rehabilitation services for people with disabilities in low-income and middle-income countries, by making optimum use of local resources. Since then, **CBID** has evolved into a **multisectoral strategy** to address the broader needs of people with disabilities, ensuring their **participation and inclusion** in society and enhancing their quality of life. **CBID** programs provide a link between people with disabilities and development initiatives. **The CBID guidelines to whom the proposal should be based on, target the key sectors of development that need to become inclusive so that people with disabilities and their families become empowered, contributing to an inclusive society or 'society for all'. As community involvement is an essential element of development, the guidelines strongly emphasize the need for CBID programs to move towards involvement of the community.**

You Able Onlus, with Italian Campaign to Ban Landmines Onlus (UNMAS) support the Paola Biocca Project, an orthopaedic workshop in Amman managed by the Jordan non profit organization Life Line Consultancy and Rehabilitation.

#### **AIM**

The aim of our call is to **train and empower young Jordan rehabilitation professionals in order to promote their direct engagement in planning and realization of a CBID program in their own country. Final aim is to realize 2 CBID projects on the ground, in Jordan.**

#### **BUDGET**

Applicants selected will have a scholarship to cover expenses during the realization of the 2 projects, **the total budget available is 12.000,00 euros**, any cost related to the

project realizations have to be included in the total budget. The liquidation of the scholarship will be in several stages and will be completed only when the project is completed. the timing will be defined following the signing of a private agreement with the 4 fellows and according to the times that the project needs to be carried out (**max 10 months**).

### **Proposal Guidelines**

The applicant will submit a proposal addressing the needs of people with disabilities and/or their families in any area he/she is interested on or has direct experience of.

Language of the proposal: English

The proposal will be in line with Community Based Rehabilitation principles.

**Applications presented by teams with different specializations, skills and abilities will be assessed with greater impact.**

**The project may include collaboration with the staff of the orthopedic center of the Paola Biocca project, its clients or simply the use of the center as a base for operating.**

**Key elements:** Analysis of the context and the need, elaboration of the proposal and ability to satisfy the need, detailed budget, sustainability prospects, coordination with local institutions / services.

**The proposal must be written in English, 1 file (pdf), sent to: [jordanproject@youable.org](mailto:jordanproject@youable.org), before 31 March 2020.** Proposals received after the deadline will not be considered. ### **Eligibility Criteria and Requirements**

Projects can be submitted by one person or a team (maximum of 4 people for 1 project), they can be workers, recently graduated or near graduation in the Faculty of Rehabilitation of Amman University (in Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Orthotics and Prosthetics, Speech Therapy).

Applications must only be submitted by candidates holding an appropriate academic qualification (graduation or nearby graduation) and applicants should not be over 30 years old by the deadline of this call. If the project is submitted by a team, this can also include at maximum 1 people not graduated and above 30 years old requirement.

### **Selection and Award Process**

All proposals will be reviewed and evaluated according to merit based on appropriateness, precision, clarity and feasibility of proposed approach. A ranking will be published on the website [www.paolabiocccacenter.eu](http://www.paolabiocccacenter.eu).

After the selection, applicants will attend a seminar in Amman of maximum 5 days in which they will be supported in elaborating the proposal from an Italian team, defining the activities and a detailed time planning which will be supervised remotely by the same team with the on-site support of the staff of the Paola Biocca Project . Subsequently the applicants will also have concrete and on-site support from the Italian theme in the realization phase of their project. The project must be completed by December 2020, under penalty of loss of the scholarship.
